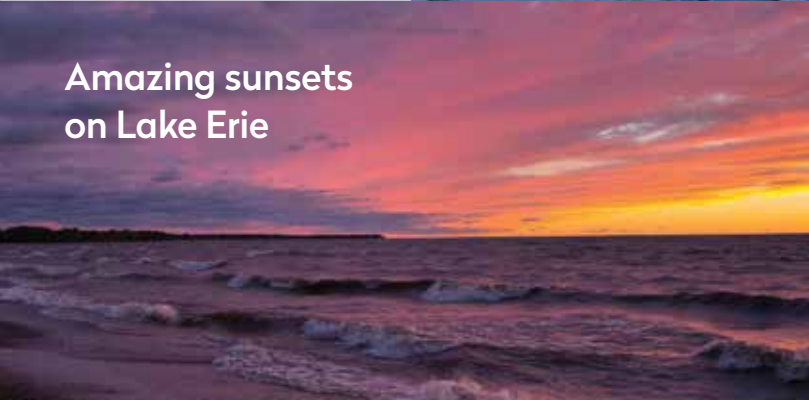

WHY STUDY AT FREDONIA?

- ▶ Fredonia is one of the oldest schools within the State University of New York (SUNY) - the largest comprehensive university system in the United States
- ▶ You will have the opportunity to work one-on-one with faculty mentors

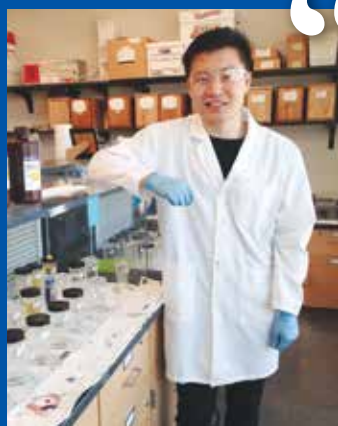

TUITION AND FEES

We currently require direct (English ready) international undergraduate and graduate students to document approximately \$32,000 (before scholarship) to cover the cost of tuition, fees, room and board for their first academic year of study. This documentation allows accepted applicants to be eligible for an F1 student visa.

International Pathway Program - TOEFL 45 iBT and IELTS 4.5

The International Pathway Program is designed for students who are ready to start on a degree program but who still need to work on English skills or build confidence before full-time degree enrollment. Students in a Pathway are guaranteed admission to a degree program and start with a mixture of ESL supportive and credit-bearing classes that will count toward that program. Pathway length varies by placement level, which will be confirmed during orientation.

HONORS PROGRAM

International undergraduate applicants are able to apply for the Fredonia Honors Program. Admitted students will be considered for a \$1,500 one-time award.

GRADUATE ASSISTANTSHIPS

Graduate students may apply for a graduate assistantship upon acceptance into one of our graduate programs. Our competitive assistantships cover up to 18 credit hours/year of New York State tuition, plus a small living stipend.

ADVANCED CREDIT

Accepted applicants who completed their Cambridge International (AS and/or A Levels) exams, International Baccalaureate (IB) Higher Level exams, Advanced Placement (AP) exams, or the College Level Examination Program (CLEP) general exams will be reviewed for college credit at Fredonia. Advanced credits to Fredonia will be awarded based on minimum subject scores.
